The Rebekah Assembly of Arizona Scholarship Opportunity is available for an Arizona resident to attend any accredited two or four-year college/university or vocational trade school to earn a certificate and/or degree. The scholarship is based on academic ability, community service, and personal development. Applicants must submit a completed application along with a letter outlining expected goals to be reached as a result of further education, and three letters of reference.

General Instructions

PLEASE FOLLOW DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY AND COMPLETELY, FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN REJECTION OF APPLICATION

- 1. Applicants must use the current official Rebekah scholarship form, which must be dated and signed by the Student, parent(s) or guardian(s) where applicable. All applications and statements are required to be signed. Typewritten applications are preferred or must be legibly handwritten. A recent photograph of the applicant, with signature on the reverse side, must be firmly attached to the application.
- 2. Applications and all supporting documents must be in English.
- 3. Official high school transcript of the student's records must be submitted. Records may be photocopies that bear an original signature of the proper authority.
- 4. A current dated and signed recommendation, <u>RESTRICTED</u> to 250 words or less, from the Principal or Counselor or teacher in authority at the school the applicant is currently attending is required. Each recommendation must be enclosed in a sealed envelope and returned to the student for enclosure in the scholarship packet.
- 5. Include one letter of endorsement from a responsible community (NONSCHOOL) person. This person should not be related to the applicant, but can be a business person, minister or civic leader. The person should be capable of reporting the applicant's participation in the community in terms of work service, leadership, notable skills and outstanding recognition. **Do not refer to school accomplishments.** This should be

- enclosed in a sealed envelope and returned to the student for enclosure in the scholarship packet.
- 6. All parts of the application (application, principal's/counselor's/teacher's statement, non-school endorsement, and official transcript) must be enclosed in one packet and must be returned to the Scholarship committee <u>Rebekah Assembly of Arizona Attn.
